Shaping Government Health IT Connections

On March 15, HHS announced an additional \$162 Million in ARRA funds to help states facilitate health information exchange (HIE) and advance Health IT. The awards are part of the \$2 billion effort to achieve widespread meaningful use of Health IT and to provide use of an electronic health record (EHR) by every citizen by 2014. Every state and eligible territory has now been awarded funds under this program. 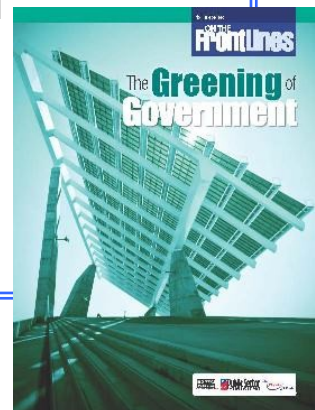
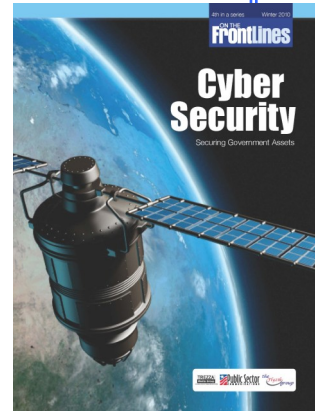
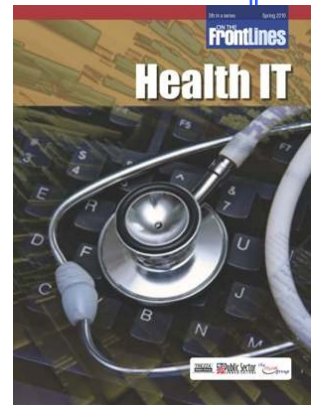
